Little Known Black History Facts in Ft Lauderdale, FL

Fort Lauderdale, Florida, boasts a rich tapestry of Black history, with numerous notable facts and landmarks:

- Early Black Settlers: The city's development owes much to early Black settlers, including those who arrived as crew members on Spanish ships in the 1500s and 1600s.
- Provident Hospital: Established in 1938 by Dr. Von D. Mizell and Dr. James Sistrunk, Provident Hospital was the first medical facility in Fort Lauderdale dedicated to serving African-American patients during segregation
- Sistrunk Boulevard: this corridor is the historical heartbeat of Fort Lauderdale's oldest Black community
- Old Dillard Museum: Built in 1907, the Old Dillard Museum was the first public school for Black children in Fort Lauderdale. Today, it serves as a museum with jazz-themed exhibition spaces and hosts cultural activities that preserve the community's history and heritage.
- Eula Johnson: A prominent civil rights leader, Johnson was instrumental in efforts to end segregation in Fort Lauderdale's public beaches, schools, and restaurants. Her activism led to significant strides toward equality in the area.
